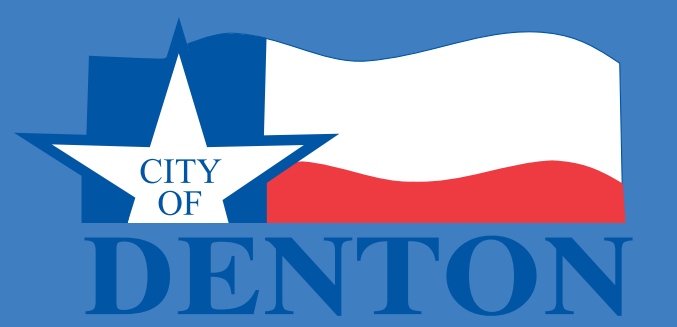

*The first phase includes a robust community engagement portion to hear the voice of Denton residents and understand their thoughts, ideas, and concerns. Analysis will include field work, context analysis, geospatial mapping, history and policy research and review of all previous preservation efforts.*

*The second phase tests out multiple policy-driven strategies that cater best to the Denton community. The planning team will focus on economic development strategies including adaptive use ordinances, property tax abatements, grant opportunities, and nation-wide best practices.*

## **PLANNING TEAM**

- **Historic Landmark Commission:** Recommends to the Planning & Zoning Commission and City Council buildings, structures, sites, districts, and areas in the city to be preserved and designated as historic landmarks; regulates design review for designated properties and districts.
- **The Lakota Group:** Chicago based urban planning and landscape architecture team. With guidance from the Historic Landmark Commission, we are leading the planning effort with an understanding that there is immediacy and importance to updating Denton's Historic Preservation Plan.
- **CLUE Group:** The Community Land Use and Economics Group is a small, specialized consulting firm that helps community leaders create vibrant downtowns and neighborhood commercial centers.

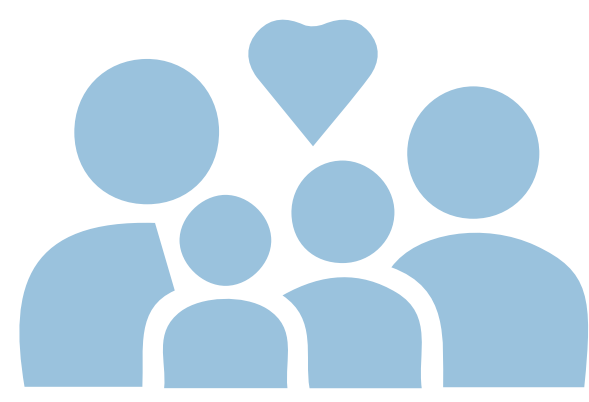

Denton's population is projected to grow 10% in the coming five years. Planned growing patterns is one key in preserving the City's historic assets.



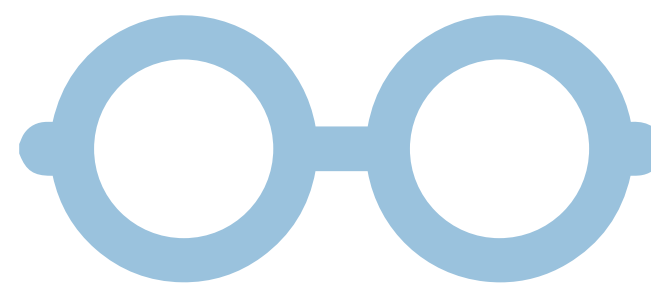
