Community Preservation Plan

The City of Bloomington has initiated a planning process to prepare a Community Preservation Plan. The central objectives of this plan are to update the 2004 Historic Preservation Plan, assess the City's historic preservation programs and policies, establish historic contexts for the City, make recommendations for identifying historic resources and potential designations, assess preservation's role in the broader planning process, and conduct a thorough community engagement process. With this Community Preservation Plan, the community desires to build on past successes while recognizing that additional efforts are needed to identify priority areas for preservation, reinvestment, and economic development and to shape and enhance the City's character. The City has engaged The Lakota Group, a preservation planning firm based in Chicago, Illinois to help create the plan.

A well-researched and prepared community preservation plan is one that is produced with the input and participation of the citizens and stakeholders of Bloomington. Along these lines, direct involvement by community members is welcomed and strongly encouraged.
